It has been a busy month for the club in which we have plenty of exciting updates to share and we look at what is coming up.

### Funding and sponsorship

The club has gained 3 sponsors in Brae Transport Ltd, Mill Lock Construction and Malhi Foodstores. We are extremely grateful to all of our sponsors who provide funding to our club to ensure we can continue to operate for the long term future as well as assist with costs like equipment, registration fees and paying officials for our games. We are also delighted to be able to share that the club has been awarded further funding from the Sport England National lottery Movement fund, receiving a £8100 grant. This will go into securing our venues for at least a further 18 months (past that of which we already have booked until June 2026) this meaning we will have venue security until a minimum of December 2027 which is amazing news for the club.



### Chesterfield success with the Chesterfield and Sheffield (C.A.S) Invitational Cup

The club has made it back to back wins over Sheffield Friendly basketball having won at the Canon medical arena in September, the club followed this up with a 42-33 win at home.



### **Juniors move to 2 sessions**

Our Juniors have now moved to 2 sessions on Saturday thanks to the additional funding from the grant and our sponsors. Previously our sessions were 9:30am – 10:30am which covered all 7 – 15 year olds but having quickly oversubscribed, we have now moved to 2 sessions, 9am – 10am for our 7-10 year olds and 10am – 11am for our 11 – 15 year olds. These will continue to be held at Tupton Hall School on Saturday mornings.

## **New coaches come on board**

In addition to Jordan and Sketch, the club also welcomes Geoff Ryan who will be assisting with our Saturday sessions along with Adheel Tahir who will be joining us in the new year and also assisting the clubs junior set up as we continue to expand in that area. If you are interested in becoming a coach then please get in touch with us, we are prepared to pay for you to do the Basketball England coaching course and pay for safeguarding/DBS and associated licence fees, all we ask is some commitment to assisting with delivery of our sessions (this will be flexible).
